*Game Tight Youth Athletic Foundation* has pioneered an unprecedented, groundbreaking ‘**401(PLAY)**’ Basketball Association designed to, not only, provide an alternative outlet to high quality competition, but also contribute financial rewards to teams that participate in our events.

- Our Association will be comprised of boys and girls basketball teams/organizations from the State of Texas.
  - Age groups: ***Boys and Girls*** 5<sup>th</sup> grade - 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

**This is how our 401(PLAY) Revenue Sharing Concept works:**

- Teams pay a franchise fee of \$200.00 to become an Active Franchise member of the Association. This franchise fee gives each team a (2) year membership into the Association. **(Due for Renewal every year)**
- Each team pays the registration fee for each league and tournament that *Game Tight Youth* hosts. And your team benefits from playing.  
**Sort of like a Youth Sports 401(K)**
- A portion of the revenue generated from each tournament or league event that the team participates in will be divided amongst each team that participates.
- Each team will receive their donation proceeds within 1-week after the total completion of the league or tournament. **Contributions do not apply to fundraising events or other events and activities that *Game Tight Youth* associates itself with.**
